- REFUND** I understand that there will be **NO REFUNDS** of any kind except where RSA is unable to provide a coach for a team.
- GAMES & PRACTICE** I understand that my child must follow the rules of the RSA, which include good sportsmanship on and off the field and attendance to all practices and games unless a valid excuse has been provided to the child's coach.
- RIGHT to PLAY** It is the policy of the RSA that each player attending a game will play at least two quarters (Unless otherwise requested by the player and parents) and as long as the player adheres to the RSA rules. **Requests for Team(s), specific Coaches or Teammate(s) will not be accepted.**
- COACHES** All Coaches for RSA are required by our Insurance Carrier to have the following forms on file: RSA Coaches Application, RSA Safe Kids Form and NJ Disclosure Statement. Coaches NOT in compliance will not be allowed on the sidelines. Additionally, coaches are required to adhere to the National Youth Sports Code of Conduct and act responsibly. Violations of conduct can result in suspension and removal.

Parental Consent / Medical Release

- INJURY** I understand that there are certain risks inherent in the practice and play of soccer, as well as in traveling and other related activities incidental to my child's participation in this sport. I am willing to assume these risks on my child's behalf. For players requiring glasses, please refer to the NJ law on safety glass. RSA & NWBSA are not held responsible.
- CHILD'S HEALTH** I hereby certify that my child is fully capable of participating in the game of soccer. I hereby certify that my child is healthy and has no physical or mental disabilities or infirmities that would restrict full participation in these activities except for the ones listed below.
- WAIVER** As a parent or legal guardian of the child named above, I give my full consent and approval of my child to participate as a member of an RSA team.
- I hereby waive, release and hold harmless the Ramsey Soccer Association, its officers, coaches, sponsors, and representatives for any injury my child may suffer in the normal course of participating in the game of soccer regardless of cause.

Medical Release:

Code of Conduct Policy

Youth sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social, and emotional development of children. Therefore, it is essential for parents, coaches, spectators, and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Furthermore, parents, coaches, spectators, and officials involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect, and self-control. We ask that you pledge to be responsible for your words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in all Ramsey Soccer events and shall conform your behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. I will engage in sportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
2. I will encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in sportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
3. I will not engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
4. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
5. I will not engage in the use of profanity or any other offensive language.
6. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in the use of profanity or any other offensive language.
7. I will, and will encourage my child, to treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee with respect.
8. I will not engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
9. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
10. I will not initiate a fight or scuffle, or retaliate, with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.
11. I will not encourage my child, or any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle, or retaliate, with any coach, parent, player, participant, official, or any other attendee.

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to inform any friend or family member attending a Ramsey Soccer event on behalf of my child of Conduct Policy. Anyone who fails to conform their conduct to the preceding code of conduct while attending, coaching, officiating, or participating in a youth Ramsey Soccer event will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by the league (NWBSA) or organization (Ramsey Soccer Assoc.)
2. Written warning issued by the league or organization.
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a soccer event issued by the league or organization or by someone who is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection by the league or organization.
4. Suspension from multiple soccer events by the league or organization or by the appropriate official authorized to issue such suspension by the league or organization.
5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by the league or organization.
6. Monetary fine when imposed by NWBSA. (Northwest Bergen Soccer Association)
